Local disaster management:

- □ Strategic partnership with 2 Municipal Councils.
- □ Membership on the Parish Disaster Committee.
- 10 Community Disaster Response Teams have been mobilized, (8 have received specialized training – (112 persons).
- 29 Community residents and project staff received training in VCA. Four hundred and seventy-four residents exposed to VCA Community Exercises and Information Sessions.

Institutional linkages and advocacy

- Partnership with NDO and Municipal Councils
- National Disaster Risk Reduction Workshop (50 participants)
- Steering Committee (comprising 10 key stakeholders)
- Project has facilitated greater focus on vulnerable groups such as older persons, persons with disabilities and children in disasters.







Information, education and communication

- 1,000 residents participated in Disaster Information Fairs and Symposium and receive – disaster preparedness tips, medical services,)
- 50 persons received training in care and support of older persons and persons with disabilities in emergencies.
- 25 residents received training in Shelter Management and Light Search and Rescue.
- □ 1,000 Family Disaster Plans completed.
