Expected Result:

Vulnerable communities have increased knowledge, skills and resources to conduct disaster mitigation, preparedness and response activities

Indicators:

25% increase in the understanding of the vulnerability and the measures taken to reduce risk, as indicated through KAP surveys in 31 communities

31 communities and 23 schools with contingency plans that are validated and tested

***5 countries have Country Profiles related to disaster risk management

***Community based disaster plans tied into larger RC & government
response plans***

***Hazard mitigation projects identified through VCA submitted to local
government & other stakeholders***

Small scale infrastructure

Expected Result:

The hazards threatening individual vulnerable households have been mitigated through small scale infrastructure initiatives

Indicators:

31 communities have implemented mitigation activities to tackle hazards identified through the VCA process

8,329 individuals made safer through mitigation activities
