Key achievements

Local disaster management

- 32** *Communities in which community-based DRR is being conducted*
- 22** *Comm. Disaster Response Teams established*
- 23** *Community Disaster Plans developed*
- 19** *Schools with disaster preparedness actions*
- 41** *First Aid trainings conducted*



Key achievements

Institutional linkages and advocacy

Suriname: Engagement of MoE to include DP in school curricula; Peace Corps for CCA; District Commissioners.

T&T: "Urban hot zones": engagement with community stakeholders & local councillors and Port of Spain City Corporation; TEMA & TT Red Cross partnership in school actions.

SVG: Partnership with the National Emergency Office for Country Profile development; Radio Amateurs for telecom trainings.



Key achievements

Institutional linkages and advocacy

Barbados: *Fire Service, Community Development, Constituency Empowerment, schools, churches & UNDP.*

Grenada: *Engagement with Ministry of Health, Ministry of Education, Youth and Social Development organisations, Police, NaDMA, Digicel, Lime, Grenlec and Solid Waste enterprise.*



Key achievements

Institutional linkages and advocacy

IFRC:

- *UNISDR cooperation regarding Country Profile Development; currently establishing stronger engagement with CDEMA for Country Profile development; support National Societies with the engagement of NDOs for Country Profile development; cooperation with other donors using information and analysis gained through DIPECHO project.*



Key achievements

Information, education and communication

Introduction of CCA awareness modules into training sessions.

Development of "Safe House Module" including flooding preparedness component.

Song competition in Barbados and Grenada to raise DRR awareness.

Currently rolling out surveys to measure effectiveness of public education actions.



Key achievements

Small scale infrastructure and services

19 *Social micro-project in progress*

Examples: *Garbage removal; public washing point rehabilitation; containment walls for landslide and flooding; installation of railings; construction of walkways and drains; installation of evacuation signage.*



Key achievements

Stockpiling of emergency and relief items

Countries with pre-positioned non-food items:

Cuba, Jamaica, Suriname and Guyana

Target: 2.500 families

Stock: tents, blankets, kitchen sets, buckets, jerry cans, hygiene kits, mattresses, tarpaulins, mosquito nets, first aid kits, chlorine tablets, 1 pumping kit and 1 bladder tank.
