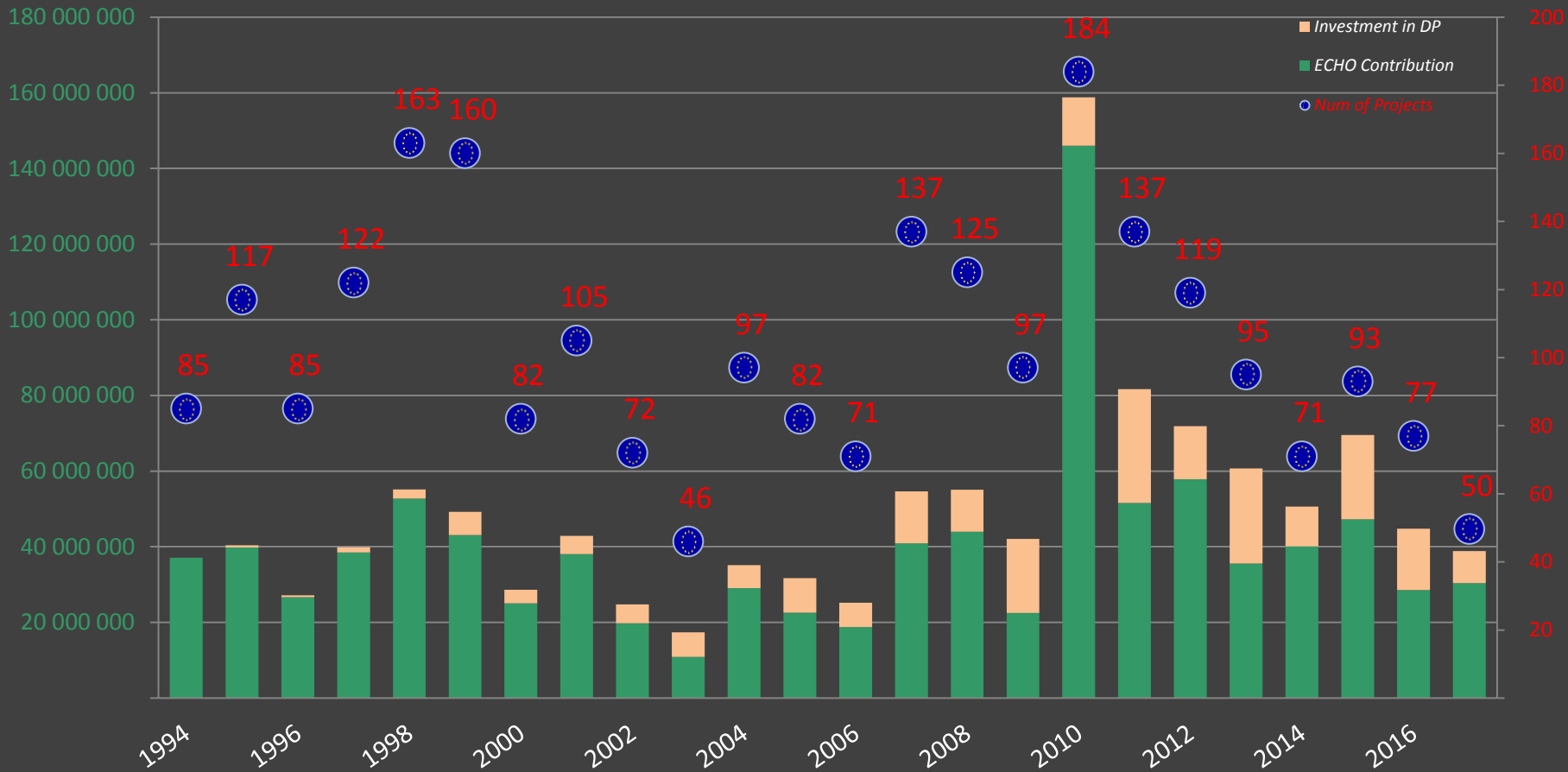

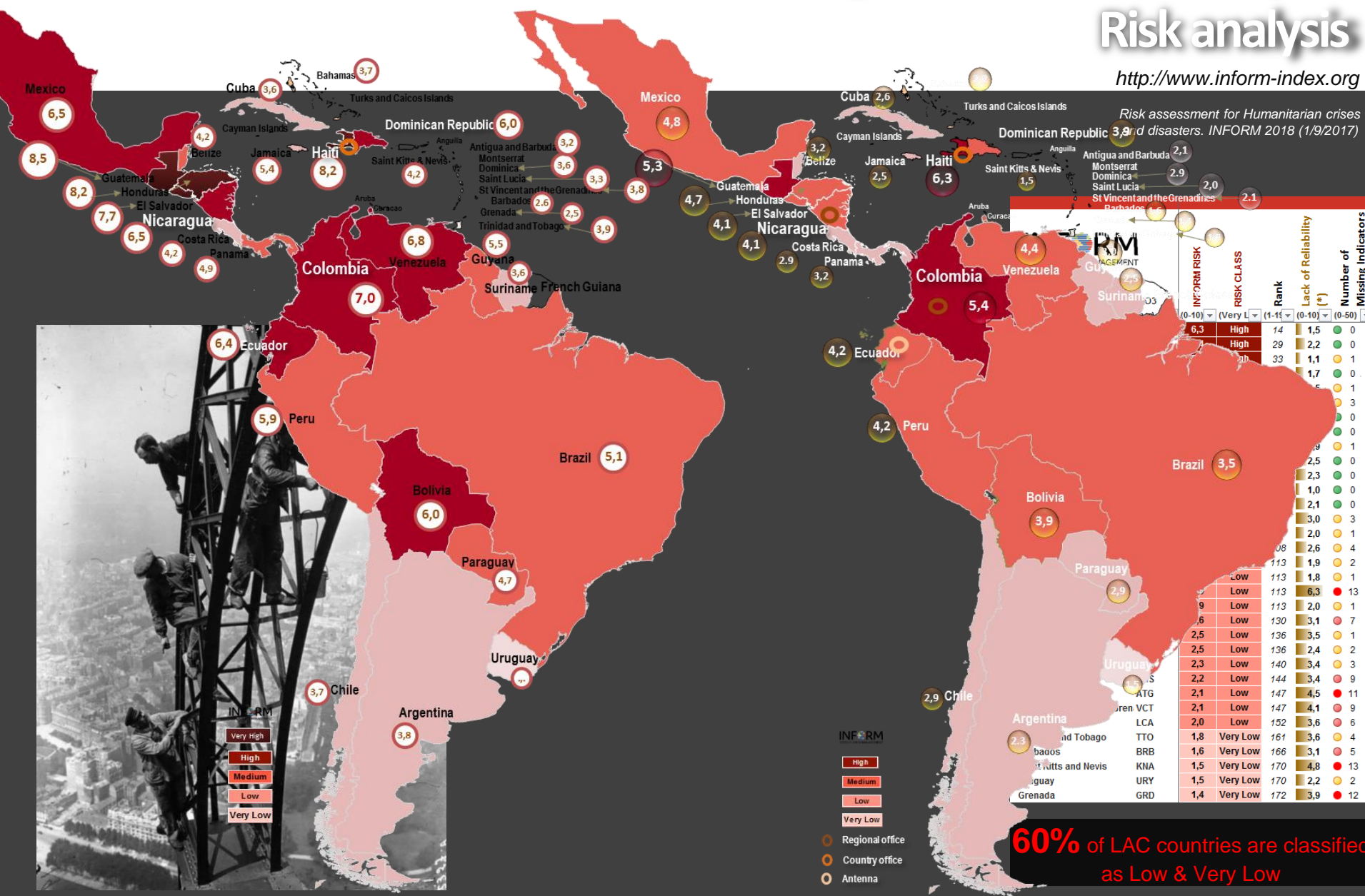

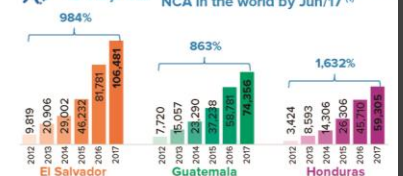
Northern Countries of C Snapshot of the Situation

240,142 Refugees and asylum-seekers from NCA in the world by Jun/17 ⁽¹⁾



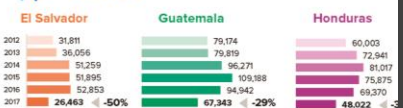
62,775 new asylum applications from NCA nationals in the world btw. Jan-Jun 2017 ⁽²⁾

8 out of every 100 new asylum applications in the world btw. Jan-Jun 2017 was from an NCA national, despite representing only **0.4%** of world population ⁽³⁾

174,000 Internally displaced persons in 20 municipalities of Honduras between 2004-2014 ⁽⁴⁾



141,828 Deportations to the NCA in 2017 ⁽⁵⁾

Northern Countries of Central America: Protection Concerns

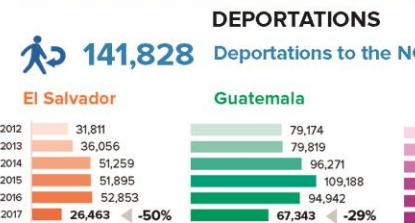
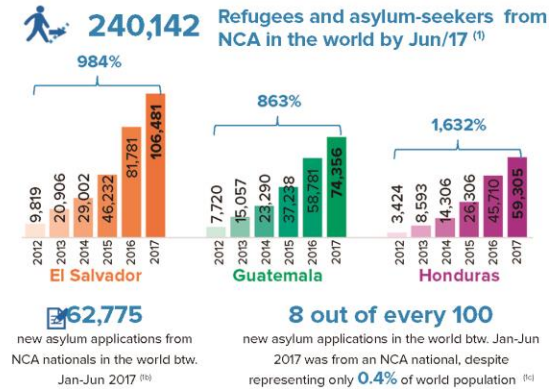
Snapshot of the Situation

Extremely high levels of violence are having severe impacts on the populations of the Northern Countries of Central America (El Salvador, Guatemala and Honduras). Multiple forms of violence in public and private spheres, the strong presence of armed criminal groups, weak institutions, and widespread social and economic exclusion produce devastating effects on access to social services, the rule of law, livelihood opportunities, human rights and development overall.

Such complex contexts call for a coordinated approach between humanitarian and development actors and broad regional coordination as well as close monitoring of vulnerable populations in order to ensure an appropriate protection response.

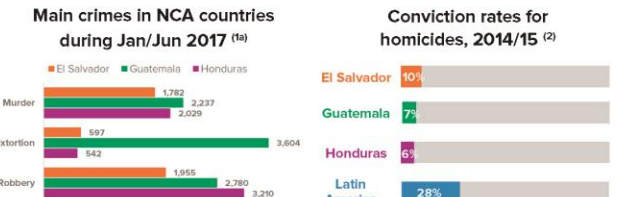
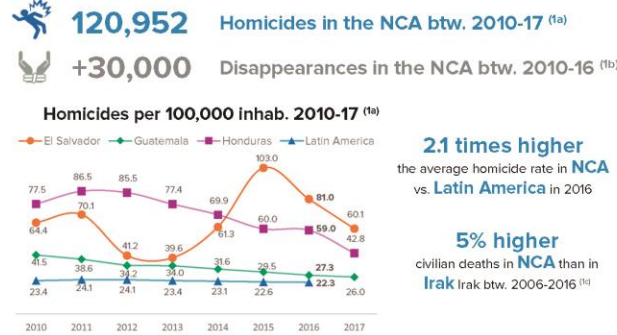

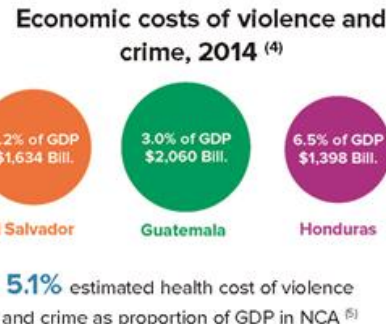

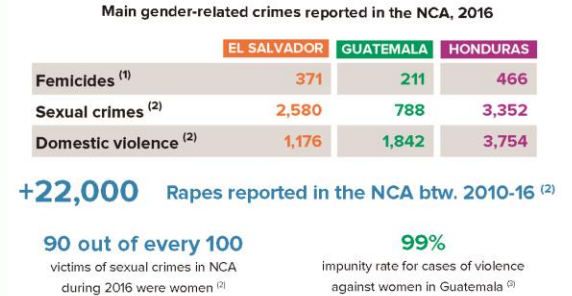
Victimization and perception ⁽³⁾

34 out of every 100 persons in NCA reported that they or their relatives were victims of a crime in 2016

43 out every 100 persons in NCA perceived public security, violence and gangs as the main problems in their countries in 2016

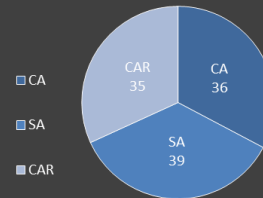

- 1 HIP modification (Peru)

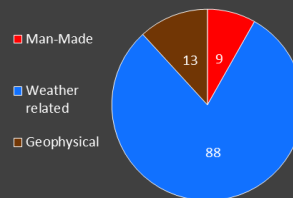
2017 Second semester

- 1 new Decision (EDF) (Caribbean)

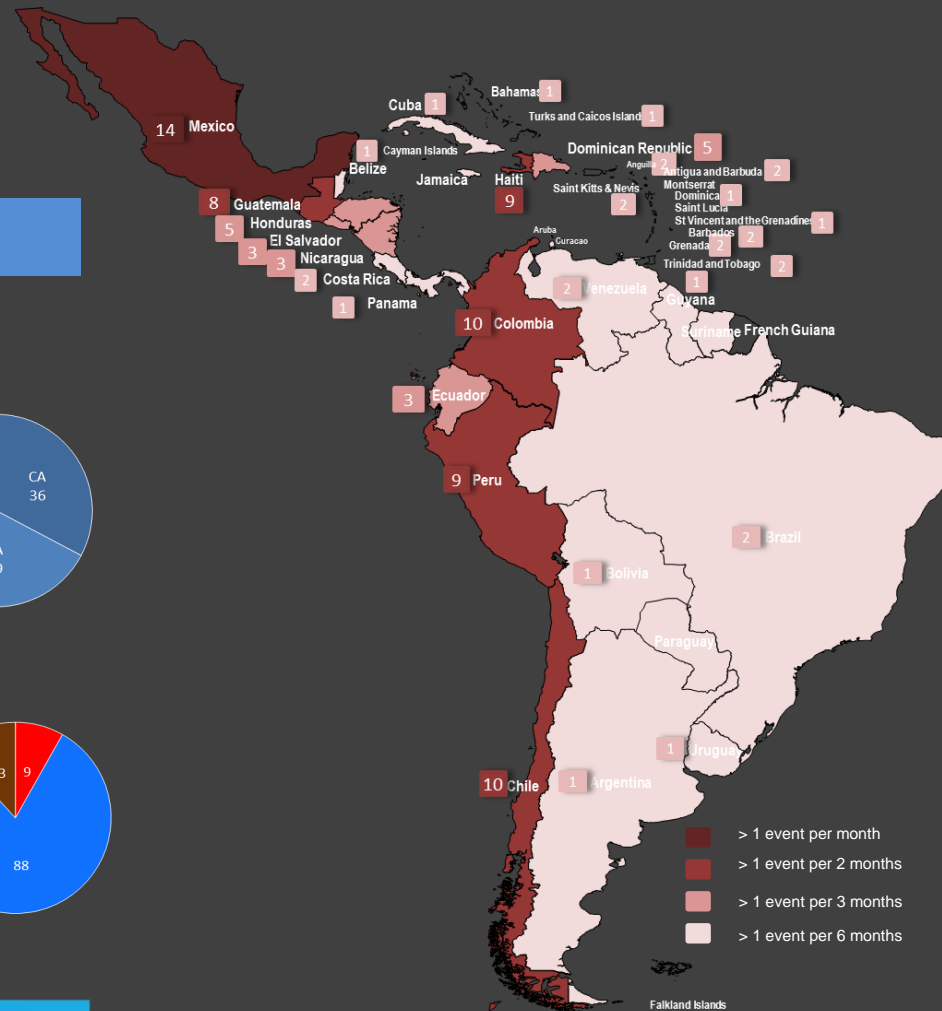

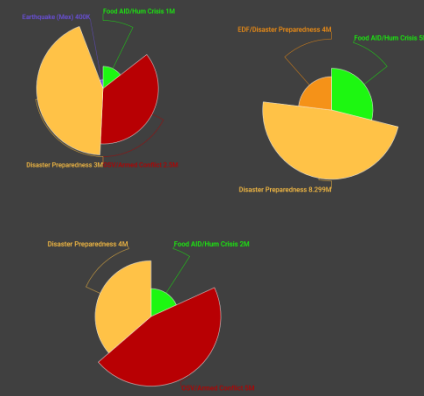
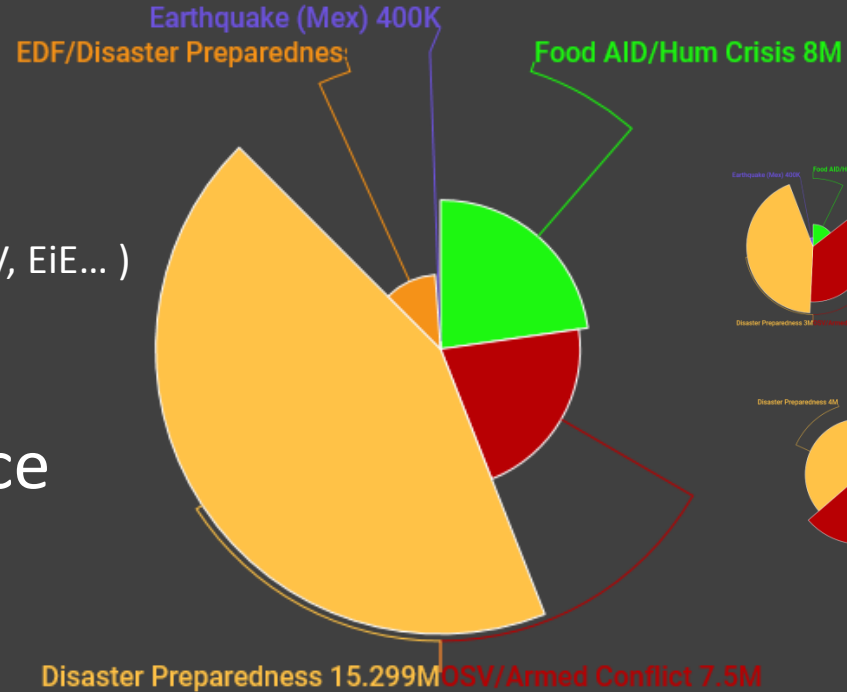
Averages of amounts and beneficiaries per projects
