Key EU Regional initiative in Latin American Countries EUROCLIMA (2010 – 2017)

A regional cooperation programme between the EU and 18 Latin American countries focused on Climate Change

Specific objective: Facilitate the integration of climate change mitigation and adaptation strategies and measures into Latin American public development policies and plans at national and (sub)regional levels.

Budget € 16,45M

















EUROCLIMA (2014 – 2016)

Component 1

• Exchange of experiences and information on climate change in Latin America has improved, **increasing political awareness** and Strengthening institutional capacity, knowledge and visibility of climate change.

Component 2

• Adaptation and mitigation measures of "no regrets" and/or with co-benefits have been identified and prioritised and implementation plans for these measures have been elaborated through pilot cases.

Component 3

• **Food security** has been reinforced contributing to a sustainable agriculture with a higher capacity to mitigate the effects and adapt to climate change, including desertification and soil degradation measures.

DRR-M in EUROCLIMA + Integrated drought and flood management

Preliminary ideas regarding activities following discussions in March 2016:

- Development of management plans and legal frameworks for DRM/DRR, particularly with regards to floods and droughts;
- Strengthening of information collection systems with regards to hydro-meteorological and climate data, and the development of early warning systems for floods and droughts;
- Support to incorporating disaster and climate risk management aspects in **public investment decisions** and strengthen capacity to access climate funding in areas including flood and drought management.



DRR-M in EUROCLIMA + Integrated drought and flood management

Other ideas for possible cooperation areas, deriving from EUinternal discussions:

- Voluntary peer reviews in disaster prevention and preparedness: this programme aims at enhancing policy dialogue and exchange of best practices among volunteer countries
- Risk management capability assessment guidelines: tool developed within the EU to allow EU Member States to assess their own capabilities in risk management
- European "Union Civil Protection Mechanism": idea is to develop a voluntary pool of EU Member States' response capacities to be on stand-by for urgent deployments
- EU Medical Corps: EU contribution to the WHO Global Health Emergency Workforce – quick mobilisation of medical & public health experts



From emergency to development: a bridge between ECHO activities and EU cooperation

- Within the EU ECHO finances emergency response actions. Integrating longer term considerations (pushing to link relief, rehabilitation and development) is a matter of concern.
- Important to ensure coherence between instruments therefore ongoing dialogue between EU's departments
- ECHO contributes to disaster resilience through targeted DRR and a people-centred approach, with an emphasis on joint action with other key stakeholders.
- There is a need to better link response and preparedness with longer term efforts such as climate change adaptation measures




Some other EU initiatives in DRR and Climate Change in the LAC region

- Global Climate Change Alliance+ (GCCA+): LDCs & SIDS.
- DIPECHO action plan (2015-2016)EU contribution EUR38M for LAC.
- Three ongoing projects in Central America (EUR 20M), focused on strengthening the resilience of most-vulnerable people's livelihoods, mostly regarding drought events.
- Integrated Management Central American program for the Roya del Café - PROCAGICA signed last February (2016-2021) (EUR 15M)
- ECHO Initiative to increase Resilience to Drought in the Central American Dry Corridor and Cuba, Dominican Republic and Haiti.
- EUR 14M funds committed to CCRIF (Caribbean Catastrophes Risk Insurance Facility). Multi-country catastrophe risk pooling mechanism for Central America and the Dominican Republic.
- ACP-EU Natural Disaster Risk Management CARIFORUM (EUR 20M)
